DEGREE OF SEPARATION

Marco Tagliafico

Opening on Thursday 14th September 2023, 6 pm

A PICK GALLERY opens Marco Tagliafico's solo exhibition *Degree of separation*, and the Berlin artists' group show *All over*, on Thursday 14th September at 6 p.m., in via Galliari 15/C, Turin.

Marco Tagliafico (Alessandria, 1985) elaborates landscapes that in a perfect mix of photography, painting and drawing oscillate between abstraction and figuration. The exhibition is articulated in a narrative that begins with the series *Aria di vetro* (Air of glass) where cyanotypes and painted glass plates merge with images, blurring and losing their initial definition, through the superimposition of analogue prints. The glass prevents us from seeing some parts of the image and emphasises others, just as our perception often tends to be partial and distorted.

A series of works of the same format, executed in various shades of blue and displayed in sequence, create different horizon lines on an entire wall. Each work contains a landscape and all together they create other unprecedented landscapes. Depending on the colour and technique, the works can suggest high mountain peaks or deep sea to the observer.

A fundamental element of Tagliafico's poetics is the continuous search for a horizon, a gaze towards something that by its nature is constantly receding and escaping. For *Degree of separation* exhibition, the artist created a site-specific intervention that can physically bring people into his work. The installation expands in the space showing the various layers that are not normally entirely apparent.

The exhibition will be visible until October 21th, 2023.

On the occasion of *OVERTURE 2023* promoted by **TAG Torino Art Galleries**, on Thursday, September 14th, A PICK GALLERY will be open from 6 pm until 11 pm.
